REVISED PROSPECTUS FOR Ph.D. IN VETERINARY & ANIMAL SCIENCES - 2020-21

PART – I

RULES FOR ADMISSION TO Ph.D. DEGREE PROGRAMME 2020-21

1. PREAMBLE

Maharashtra Animal and Fishery Sciences University, Nagpur has been constituted under of Maharashtra Animal and Fishery Sciences University Act, 1998 (Maharashtra Act XVII).

Executives of the University

- i) Hon'ble Governor of Maharashtra State and Chancellor of Maharashtra Animal and Fishery Sciences University, Nagpur.
- ii) Hon'ble Minister of Animal Husbandry, Dairy Development and Fisheries, Maharashtra State and Pro-Chancellor of Maharashtra Animal and Fishery Sciences University, Nagpur.
- iii) Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Maharashtra Animal and Fishery Sciences University, Nagpur.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon University vide provision in Section-5 (Chapter-II) of the MAFSU Act, 1998, admission to the Ph.D. degree programme in the faculty of Veterinary Science shall be held in accordance with the following regulations.

2. COMPETENT AUTHORITY

Registrar, Maharashtra Animal and Fishery Sciences University, Nagpur shall be the competent authority for admissions. However, the Associate Deans of Nagpur Veterinary College, Nagpur; Mumbai Veterinary College Mumbai; KNP College of Veterinary Science, Shirwal; College of Veterinary & Animal Sciences, Parbhani; College of Veterinary & Animal Science, Udgir and Post Graduate Institute of Veterinary Science, Akola shall be responsible officers for effecting the admissions. The decision of the Competent Authority shall be final.

3. DEFINITIONS

- i. **'Candidate'** means an applicant who desires to seek admission to first year Ph.D. Degree course in Maharashtra Animal and Fishery Sciences University, Nagpur.
- ii. **'Veterinary College/Institute'** means College/Institute to impart veterinary education in Maharashtra Animal and Fishery Sciences University, Nagpur.
- iii. **'Competent Authority'** means the authority empowered to invite the applications and effect admissions as per the rules.
- iv. **'Intake Capacity'** means the number of sanctioned seats.
- v. **'Course'** means a unit of instructions or segment of subject matter as specified in course calendar to be covered in a semester. It has a specific number, title and credits.



- vi. **'Semester'** means a period consisting of minimum 110 instructional days excluding the period of examination.
- vii. **'Syllabus and Curriculum'** means the series of courses selected and designed to provide training to meet the prescribed requirements for a degree as specified by Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR).
- viii. **'Credit Hours'** means the weekly unit of work recognized for any particular course as per the course catalogue issued by the University. A lecture class of one hour per week shall be counted as one credit for theory, whereas a practical class of two hours duration or working period of four hours duration in clinical veterinary teaching hospital per week shall be counted as one credit hour for practical.
- ix. **'Academic Year'** means a period consisting of minimum 220 instructional days i.e. two semesters of instructions excluding time spent for semester end examination and semester break.
- x. **'Course of Study'** means Ph.D. degree course consisting of curriculum and syllabus spread over three complete academic years after successful completion of all credit hours provided in the syllabus as prescribed in regulations of Maharashtra Animal & Fishery Sciences University, Nagpur.
- xi. **'Constituent Colleges'** means colleges directly under the control of Maharashtra Animal & Fishery Sciences University, Nagpur.
- xii. **In-Service Candidate** means a regular employee of any University / State Govt. / Central Govt. / ICAR or any such Institutions.
- xiii. **Qualifying Examination** means M.V.Sc. Degree Course examination or equivalent.
- xiv. Entrance Test means **"MAFSU Ph.D. Written Examination + Interview"**.

4. **ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS FOR "MAFSU Ph.D. ENTRANCE TEST – 2020" and ADMISSION FOR Ph.D. DEGREE PROGRAMME - 2020-21.**

- i) All the desirous candidates (Regular and In-service) must have passed M.V.Sc. Degree Course with CGPA 7.00 and 6.50 CGPA in 10.00 point scale for Unreserved and Reserved Category respectively and should possess Master Degree/ Provisional Certificate at the time of application.

Candidate belonging to other than Maharashtra state must secure minimum 7.00 CGPA in 10.00 point scale at M.V.Sc degree course or a degree equivalent thereto.

- ii) The candidates desirous to seek admission to Ph.D. Degree Course shall have to appear for the **"MAFSU Ph.D. Entrance Test-2020"**.
- iii) The written examination shall be followed by an interview, conducted by the University at University Head Quarter on the notified date.
- iv) The marks obtained in written examination and interview together shall be considered for the admission to Ph.D. Degree Course. The minimum qualifying marks shall be 50% for Unreserved and 40% for Reserved category candidates.

**5. AVAILABILITY OF SEATS :**

Intake capacity, course duration, workload and eligibility for admission to Ph.D. degree course.

Note :

- i) **University Seats :** The seats at each constituent college of university shall be filled as per state merit list prepared by the university.
- ii) **ICAR Quota Seats :** Total 18 seats have been reserved as ICAR quota seats and shall be filled by Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), New Delhi through an Entrance Test (AIEE) conducted by ICAR, New Delhi. The ICAR seats remaining vacant after completion of admissions by ICAR will be filled in Special Round of admission from the State Merit list.
- iii) **NRI/FN/PIO Quota Seats :** Total 10 seats over and above existing intake capacity are reserved for candidates belonging to NRI/ FN/PIO category. They are at liberty to seek admission at any of the above mentioned constituent colleges of the University subject to the availability of the course in the concerned subject and College. NRI seats, if remained vacant will be filled in during special round of admission by the candidates from the state merit list. The desirous candidate from state merit list shall have to fill up an online option during special round of admission by paying Rs.5000/- through online payment gateway. However if admitted, the fees applicable to NRI/FN/PIO candidates (10,000 U.S. \$ per year in addition to the regular fee) will be charged to such students.
- iv) **State Government In-service Quota seats -** Eight seats over and above the intake capacity are reserved for In-service candidate of State Government of Maharashtra. They must secure minimum CGPA of **7.00** for unreserved category & **6.50** for reserved category in 10.00 point scale respectively at M.V.Sc degree course or a degree equivalent thereto. The candidate shall have to apply online for the admission. The candidate will be admitted on the basis of list of eligible candidates communicated by the office of Commissioner, Department of Animal Husbandry, Pune to the University.



6. RESERVATION OF SEATS

All reservations are given on the basis of percentage notified by the Government for respective categories and policy of the Government declared from time to time.

6.1 Unreserved seats will be 40% of total intake capacity.

6.2 Reservation of Seats:

- 30% seats shall be reserved for female candidates from unreserved as well as reserved category.
- **Physically Handicapped** : 5% seats will be filled in from the total intake capacity as per their merit and as per the procedure laid down in GR dated: 11/07/2019
- **Orphaned Candidate** : 1% seats will be filled in from the total intake capacity as per GR dated:11/07/2019
- 2% seats shall be reserved for Special Backward Class (SBC) candidates and will be filled in during second round of admission at Step IV [See Page No.19 (xxiv)]



NOTE :

- i) Caste certificate and Caste/Tribe validity certificate issued by the Competent Authority shall be considered for benefit of reserved category.
- ii) With reference to the order given by Hon'ble Supreme Court Civil appeal No.11234-48/2017, candidates from SC, ST, VJ/DT(a), NT(b), NT(c), NT(d), OBC and SBC should provide Caste Validity Certificate. However, Candidates belonging to the categories of backward classes shall be required to submit the caste certificate and Caste/Tribe validity certificate (CVC) or proof of submission of proposal to competent authority for obtaining 'Caste Validity Certificate' along with the application form.

The candidates provisionally allotted the seats under reserved category shall be required to submit CVC **upto 24/06/2021** in admitted college, failing which their provisional admission shall automatically stand cancelled without any prior notice. Such candidate however, shall be considered under unreserved category for admission during second rounds onward provided he/she fulfills the eligibility criteria.

The candidates belonging to reserved category who has not submitted CVC along with application form and not allotted the seats during 1st round, shall have to **submit CVC on or before 24/06/2021** on email admissioncvc@gmail.com failing which, their candidature shall be considered under unreserved category provided he/she fulfills the eligibility criteria.

- iii) The candidate should claim the applicable reservations in the application form.
- iv) A candidate claiming benefit of reservation under the categories of VJ/DT(a), NT(b), NT(c), NT(d), OBC and SBC shall be required to enclose Valid Non-Creamy Layer Certificate in the name of parent or guardian (only if either parents are not alive) as specified in the Government Resolution No.CBC-10/2006/CR-15/MVK-5 dated 5th June, 2006, otherwise their candidature will be considered under Unreserved category, provided they fulfill the eligibility criteria for unreserved category and submits the grievance along with difference of application fees Rs. 300/- in addition to grievance fees. The in-service candidate belonging to above category should necessarily enclosed NCL in his/her name only.
- v) Candidates belonging to 'Creamy Layer' amongst the Categories of VJ/DT(a), NT(b), NT(c), NT(d), OBC and SBC must note that the provision of reservation is NOT applicable to them.



- vi) The Non-Creamy Layer Certificate issued by the competent authority should be valid upto the last date of submission of application form will considered otherwise the claim of reservation shall be rejected.
- vii) The SBC candidates belonging to non-creamy layer will be admitted as per the provision made in GR.No.TEM-3397/12926/(9086) TE-1 dated 11-7-1997. The adjusted reservation of Special Backward Class (SBC) will be 2% of intake capacity and will be filled in during second round of admission at Step IV [See Page No.19 (xxiv)].

6.3 Other Reservations (Horizontal Reservations)

The other reservation (horizontal reservations) will be as follows:

- A) Agriculturists (AG) : 6 %
- B) Freedom Fighter (FF) : 2 %
- C) Project Affected Person (PAP) : 4 %
- D) Defense Personnel (DP) : 2 %

Total : **14 %**

(A) CERTIFICATE OF AGRICULTURIST (AG)

- 1) Agriculturist Certificate for the year 2019-20 (as per **Annexure-V**) issued by Tahsildar / Naib Tahsildar on or after 01/04/2020 shall be considered.
- 2) It should be stated in the certificate that the candidate/parents/grand parent (Paternal) owner or tenant holding agricultural land and whose main source of income is derived from personal cultivation of agricultural land.
- 3) If parent/ guardian have any source of income other than agriculture in such case claim of AG category shall be rejected.
- 4) The benefit of AG category shall not be applicable for In-service candidate.



(B) CERTIFICATE OF FREEDOM FIGHTER (FF)

A certificate of the freedom fighter of the applicant's parent / grandparent (paternal) issued under the signature of Hon'ble Prime Minister/ Chief Minister of Maharashtra State will be considered. If the certificate is issued in the name of parent (FF) OR grandparent (FF), the claim of reservation will be granted provided, the applicant has attached fresh affidavit of parent (FF) OR grandparent (FF) OR if freedom fighter is not alive then affidavit signed by Wife/Husband of FF will be considered on a stamp paper of Rs.100/- issued / purchased on or after 1/4/2020 stating the following points -

- (a) Applicant is son/daughter of the Freedom Fighter (Parents) or grand son / grand daughter of Freedom Fighter (Grand parent).
- (b) Freedom Fighter has not used this concession for any relative here before.
- (c) Freedom Fighter shall not use the concession for any relative here after, if the benefit is availed at this time.

(C) PROJECT AFFECTED PERSON CERTIFICATE (PAP)

The certificate of being project affected person issued by District Re-settlement officer/Rehabilitation officer in the prescribed format as provided in **Annexure-VI** of the prospectus will be considered.

The claim of reservation for admission under PAP category can be considered for his/her, son/daughter/brother/sister/grandson (paternal)/ grand daughter (paternal)/nominated by project affected person. If the land of applicant/applicant's parent/applicant's grand parent has been acquired by Government for MAFSU/SAU/Irrigation/Power/Defence project, the benefit shall be given to them for the purpose of education vide Govt. Resolution RPA-3995/ C.N.-183/R-1 Mumbai, Dated 22nd May, 1996.

The name of the beneficiary candidate must have been included in the project affected person certificate issued by the competent authority.

(D) DEFENSE PERSONNEL CERTIFICATE (DP)

Claim of reservation shall be granted to the children (applicant) of Defence service personnel, Ex-defence service personnel including those permanently disabled or died in action.

Candidate should be a son/daughter/widow of the person who has been a member of the Armed Forces of India and who has put in at least 5 years of Active Service and has been subject to Indian Army Act, Indian Navy Act, Indian Air



Force Act and also includes Ex-Serviceman who retired, from such service or permanently disabled or died in action. The condition of minimum active service of 5 years shall not be applicable to the service personnel who are permanently disabled or died in action.

The Candidate shall be required to enclose a certificate from the appropriate Authority of the Armed Forces not below the rank of Commandant or equivalent or from District Sainik Board certifying that the candidate fulfils the above conditions.

6.4 Reservation for Physically Handicapped candidates (PH)

Five percent seats are reserved for Physically Handicapped candidates. However, a candidate shall not be allowed admission to Ph.D. degree course, if he / she suffers disabilities in physical fitness as listed below -

- a) Disability of total body including disability of chest / spine more than 50%.
- b) Disability of lower limb of more than 50%.
- c) Disability of upper limb.
- d) Visually handicapped candidates and those with hearing disability.
- e) Candidates with progressive diseases like myopathies etc.
- f) Disabilities which otherwise would interfere in the performance of the duties of a Veterinarian.

The disability should be certified by Civil Surgeon / Medical Board and the candidate has to present him / herself before the Civil Surgeon / Medical Board. The disability certificate of the candidate from Civil Surgeon / Medical Board **should not be more than three months old from the date of submission of the application form**, failing which the claim of Physically Handicapped candidature shall be rejected. The candidate should submit the Physically Handicapped Certificate as per proforma in **Annexure-VII** only.

6.5 Reservation for female candidates

- i. 30% seats shall be reserved for female candidates as per G.R. No.MED-1300/CR-271/2000/EDN-1 Mumbai 5th June 2000. The seats so reserved shall be available for all the categories like unreserved, SC, ST, VJ/DT(a), NT(b), NT(c), NT(d), OBC, SBC & EWS.
- ii. If required number of female candidates are not available in a particular category then these seats shall be offered to male candidate of that particular category during second round of admission as per the procedure given.



6.6 Reservation for Orphaned candidates (OC) :

One percent (1%) seats of the total intake capacity will be reserved for the orphan candidate. These seats shall be filled by competent authority as per Government Resolution, Women & Child Welfare Department, No.AMJ-2011/C.R. 212 Desk 3, dated 2 April 2018 and the policy of the Government declared from time to time.

6.7 Reservation for Economically Weaker Section Candidate (EWS) :

Ten percent (10%) seats of the total intake capacity will be reserved for the Economically Weaker Section Candidate as per Government Resolution Dtd. 11/07/2019. These seats shall be filled by competent authority as per the provision mentioned in the Government Resolution No. राआधो- 4019/प्र.क्र.31/16-अ, Dtd. 12/02/2019 and क्र. राआधो ४०१९/प्र.क्र.३१/१६-अ, दिनांक-२३ डिसेंबर, २०२०. The candidate should submit the EWS certificate signed by competent authority as per proforma in **Annexure- VIII**.

7. IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

A. IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING FILLING AND SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORM

- i) Candidate is required to download the soft copy of the Prospectus available on University website (www.mafsu.ac.in). The candidate should read the prospectus carefully before filling the online application form. The desirous candidate has to apply online for the purpose of admission.
- ii) Candidate is required to visit the website and click on Ph.D degree course, log in as new user and he / she shall fill in the required details, pay the processing fees, upload scanned copies of all the required documents (preferably original documents), photograph, signature etc. and shall submit the details by clicking on the “**Submit**” link.
- iii) **Modes of Payment of Registration Fees :**
 - a) The application fees for Unreserved candidate is Rs.1000/- and for Reserved candidate is Rs.700/-.
 - b) The candidate from the states other than Maharashtra & In-service candidate of State Govt. of Maharashtra shall have to pay Rs.1000/-.
 - c) Candidate shall pay the requisite application fees online through Net Banking or Credit / Debit Card.
 - d) Fees once paid will not be refunded due to any reason.



- iv) The candidates are advised to furnish accurate information in all the columns. The university shall not be responsible for any discrepancy appearing in the application form which may result in deciding disadvantages merit position of the applicant.
- v) Application form complete in all respect and received online on or before the last date of submission shall only be considered for admission. Before submission of application form, the candidate should ensure that the information given in the application form is correct and documents are correctly uploaded and readable.
- vi) In case any candidate submits more than one application forms, the latest filled application form complete in all respect will only be considered.
- vii) The In-service candidate should necessarily submit “No Objection Certificate” from the employer.
- viii) For application flow and admission procedure details refer **Annexure-XIV**.

B. OTHER IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

- i) Candidates are required to ascertain their eligibility before applying and to submit the required documents/certificates along with application form to make them eligible for selection process on merit basis, claim of additional weightage points and reservations.
- ii) The candidate domiciled of Other State shall not be considered for any Caste / Category benefit / Reservation.
- iii) If any document / certificate is in language other than Marathi / Hindi / English, a translation in English duly certified by the competent / issuing authority should be uploaded along with that document.
- iv) If certain document/certificate to be attached is having more than one page (eg. NCL certificate, Affidavit, Research paper, Marksheets for more than one attempt, etc.) then it shall be uploaded together by converting them in one PDF or JPEG file. Incomplete uploading of document will not be considered.
- v) No grievances / arguments of the candidates shall be entertained, if he / she fails to get the admission by his/her own negligence, late reporting, technical difficulties, personal problems etc.



8. LIST OF CERTIFICATES/DOCUMENTS TO BE UPLOADED DURING FILLING OF ONLINE APPLICATION FORM.

A) LIST OF ESSENTIAL CERTIFICATES/DOCUMENTS

The candidates shall upload the following original/clearly legible self attested documents while filling online application form. Before submission of application form, the candidates should ensure that the uploaded documents are clearly visible. If any uploaded document is not clearly visible then reservation / weightage / eligibility (whichever is applicable) shall not be given.

- a) **Mark sheet / Grade card of qualifying examination.**
- b) **Degree Certificate/Provisional Degree Certificate of qualifying examination.**
- c) **College Leaving Certificate/ Bonafide Certificate**

The candidate must upload the leaving certificate issued by the college last attended. If the candidate is already admitted in any other institute and applies to seek the admission for the Ph. D. Degree Course then the 'Bonafide Certificate' of current year issued from the concerned College/Institute will be considered.

In respect of candidate from out of Maharashtra State (**Other State-O.S. Candidates**), if it is not possible to upload College Leaving Certificate, he/she shall have to upload '**Migration/Bonafide Certificate**' of respective College/Institute. However, if such candidate is admitted then he/she shall have to produce original College Leaving Certificate within a period of 7 working days from the date of admission failing which his/her provisional admission may be cancelled.

- d) **Domicile / Residence certificate** issued by the Competent Authority indicating minimum 3 years stay of candidate or his/her parents in preceding 10 years in Maharashtra state or candidate's school or college leaving certificate (indicating the place of birth) or Birth certificate / graduation from the institution situated in the State of Maharashtra.

For Other State candidates, Domicile/Residence Certificate issued by the competent authority/ School or college leaving certificate (indicating the place of birth)/Birth certificate shall be considered for this purpose.



B) LIST OF CERTIFICATES/DOCUMENTS FOR RESERVATION

- a) **Caste Certificate** in the prescribed format issued by the Competent Authority designated for the purpose in the State of Maharashtra for candidates belonging to reserved category.
- b) **Caste Validity Certificate (CVC)** issued by the Competent Authority designated for the purpose in the State. The candidates shall be required to submit the caste certificate, caste/tribe validity certificate or proof of submission of proposal to competent authority for obtaining 'Caste Validity Certificate' along with the application form. However, such candidates who has submitted proof of submission of proposal for CVC shall necessarily required to submit 'Caste Validity Certificate' issued by the competent authority on or before 24/06/2021 on email admissioncvc@gmail.com as per the schedule of admission programme. The candidate failing to submit CVC even till the last date shall be considered under unreserved category provided he/she fulfills the minimum eligibility criteria for unreserved category candidate.
- c) **Non-Creamy Layer Certificate** issued by the Competent Authority for candidates seeking admission under VJ/DT(a), NT(b), NT(c), NT(d), OBC and SBC categories should be valid upto the last date of submission of application form.
- d) **Agriculturist Certificate** issued by the Tahsildar or Naib Tahsildar on or after 01/04/2020 showing that the applicant or his/her parents or grandparents (paternal) is/are owner, hold agricultural land and whose main source of income is derived from personal cultivation of land. Proforma of this certificate is at **Annexure V** of the Prospectus.
- e) **Project Affected Person Certificate** issued by the District Resettlement Officer/Rehabilitation Officer of Government of Maharashtra in the prescribed format that his/her parent's/grand parent's land has been acquired by the Government for Agricultural University/ Irrigation /Power/Defence Project. The name of the beneficiary must have been included in the Project Affected Persons Certificate issued by the competent authority. Proforma of this certificate is at **Annexure VI** of the Prospectus.
- f) **Freedom Fighter Certificate** of the applicant's parents/grand parents issued under the signature of the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India / Chief Minister of Maharashtra State. (Please refer Clause No.6.3 (B) on page No.7 of the Prospectus) along with required affidavit.



- g) **Defence Personnel Certificate** from Zilla Sainik Welfare Office/ Board/ Discharge Certificate from Officer Commanding the Regiment or Serviceman Certificate from the competent authority. (Please refer Clause No. 6.3 (D) Reservation of seats page No.7 & 8 of the prospectus).
- h) The candidates applying for admission under **'Physically Handicapped Category'** should submit the Certificate of Handicapped issued by the Competent Authority (District Civil Surgeon or Medical Board) designated in this behalf. (Please refer Clause No. 6.4 on page No.8 of the prospectus). Proforma of this certificate is at **Annexure VII** of the prospectus.
- i) **Orphaned Certificate** : The candidate willing to take admission from orphaned category are required to submit Orphaned certificate issued from Commissioner, Women and Child Development on his/her letter head with the signature of Deputy Commissioner (Child Development), Pune / Commissioner, Women and Child Development, Pune. (Please refer Clause No. 6.6 on page No.9 of the prospectus)
- j) **Economically Weaker Section Certificate** issued by the Tahsildar or Naib Tahsildar on or after 01/04/2020. (Please refer Clause No. 6.7 on page No.8 of the prospectus) Proforma of this certificate is at **Annexure VIII** of the Prospectus.
- k) **Registration/Provisional Registration Certificate of MSVC/VCI.**

C. REJECTION OF APPLICATION FORM

Application shall not be considered and shall stand rejected automatically on any one or more of the following deficiencies.

- i. If the **Grade Card / Transcript** of the qualifying examination is not uploaded.
- ii. If the **Provisional Degree Certificate or Degree Certificate or Course Completion Certificate** of the qualifying examination is not uploaded.
- iii. If the **Leaving Certificate of College/Institute (last attended) or Bonafide Certificate** of currently College /Institute or Migration Certificate of Institute/University last attended is not uploaded/not visible.
- iv. If the prescribed **application fees is not paid.**
- v. If candidate **does not fulfill the eligibility** for admission.
- vi. The application form of the physically handicapped candidates having more than 50% disability shall be rejected.



9. INSTRUCTIONS FOR MAFSU INSERVICE CANDIDATES

- i) MAFSU in-service candidates should apply online and take the print out of application form and send the hard copy of application through proper channel to the Registrar, MAFSU, Nagpur on or before the last date of the receipt of application form **i.e. 02/06/2021**.
- ii) MAFSU in-service candidates shall be allowed to appear for Ph.D. entrance examination only after receiving provisional No Objection Certificate issued by Associate Dean of respective institute/college. However, their candidature for Ph.D. admission shall be considered after receipt of “No Objection Certificate” from Registrar, MAFSU, Nagpur.
- iii) MAFSU in-service candidates shall be admitted as per University 81st Executive Council Resolution No.92/2019.
- iv) The University reserves the right to deny admission in a particular department/college owing to non-availability of qualified guide/teachers.
- v) The University reserves right to deny admission to in-service Candidate, in case vacant post is not available at the place of Ph.D. programme.
- vi) The university reserves right to deny admission to in-service candidate in case faculty strength at the place of his posting is inadequate.
- vii) The duration of course and other terms & condition for MAFSU in-service candidates, shall be as per Academic Council Resolution - 21/2002.
- viii) MAFSU in-service candidates shall have to give agreement bond stating that he / she will not leave the MAFSU for a minimum period of five (05) years after completion of Ph.D. Degree Programme.
- ix) As per the 82nd Executive Council Resolution No.4/2020, “The University reserves the right to allot the seat to the MAFSU in-service candidates in a particular College / Institute as per its administrative exigency; hence the preference / option would not be available to MAFSU in-service candidates”.

10. IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO NRI/FN/PIO CANDIDATES

- i) Ten seats over and above the existing intake capacity in the faculty of Veterinary Science for Ph.D. degree programme are reserved for NRI/FN/PIO candidates.
- ii) NRI/FN/PIO candidates desirous to seek admission for Ph.D. Degree Programme - 2020-21 in Veterinary and Animal Sciences **need not have to appear** for “MAFSU Ph.D. Entrance Test-2020”. The admission of NRI/FN/PIO candidates shall be made on the basis of merit i.e. CGPA at Master’s degree.
- iii) Minimum eligibility condition for admission to Ph.D. degree course is Master’s Degree in Veterinary Science (M.V.Sc.) in the concerned subject or degree equivalent thereto with minimum CGPA 7.00 in 10 point scale i.e. 70% marks.



- iv) Candidate with basic qualification of equivalent degree will have to complete deficiency courses as decided by the Advisor / Advisory Committee.
- v) Foreign students having DVM degree will have to undergo for at least one year, deficiency courses of 30-35 credits if they desire to take admission to the Ph.D. degree.
- vi) The NRI/FN/PIO candidates shall submit the online application form and also take the print out of the completed application form and shall submit the same along with brief resume, photo copies of X and XII Std. Marksheet / Certificate, B.V.Sc. & A.H. / B.V.Sc. Degree Certificate and Marksheet, M.V.Sc. Degree Certificate and Marksheet with CGPA not less than 7.00 in 10 point scale, College Leaving Certificate, Date of Birth Certificate, copy of passport and other proof regarding nationality.
- vii) The print out of online application of NRI/FN/PIO candidates should be submitted to **Assistant Director General (HRD), Educational Division, Indian Council of Agricultural Research, Krishi Anusandhan Bhavan - II, Pusa, New Delhi-110 012 (India)** or **Under Secretary to the Government of India, Department of Agricultural Research and Education (DARE), Krishi Bhavan, New Delhi-110 001 (India)** or **Head (Placement and Secondment) Educational Consultant India Ltd., 18- A, Sector-16-A, Noida - 201 301 (India)**.

The application completed in all respect including necessary documents submitted through any of the above mentioned authorities should reach to the Registrar, Maharashtra Animal & Fishery Sciences University, Futala Lake Road, Nagpur-01 (M.S.) (India) on or before the last of the receipt of application form i.e. **02/06/2021**. The application received after last date as well as incomplete application shall be rejected. After admission the NRI/FN/PIO candidate will have to apply for appropriate category Indian Visa to the Indian Embassy in their home country. The candidate will have to submit copy of the passport and the visa at the time of admission.

- viii) The Director of Instruction & Dean, Faculty of Veterinary Science, MAFSU, Nagpur shall be Nodal Officer for NRI/FN/PIO admission.
- ix) The medium of instruction shall be English only. The Non English speaking candidate seeking admission under NRI/FN/PIO shall have to clear English language examination of 100 marks of graduation level from Traditional University of Maharashtra immediately after his/her admission.
- x) The candidate shall have to pay fees of **\$ 10000 (U.S. Dollar)** in Indian rupees per semester in addition to regular fees as shown in **Annexure-IV**.
- xi) Candidates with privilege of Institutional Economic fees e.g. those admitted under Nepal Aid Fund shall have to pay **\$ 2000 (U.S. Dollar)** in Indian rupees per year in addition to regular fees as shown in **Annexure-IV**.



- xii) The selection of the candidate for Ph.D. Degree Programme will be made on the basis of merit and should see the final merit list and detail admission programme.
- xiii) Once the candidate secures admission under this category, he/she shall have to pay the fees applicable to NRI/FN/PIO through the course of his studies and no change in quota will be made.
- xiv) The candidate should note that the special fee paid by the candidate for NRI/FN/PIO quota seat shall not be refunded in any case.

11. ENTRANCE TEST FOR ADMISSION TO Ph.D. DEGREE PROGRAMME

The entrance test shall be conducted by the University on 13/06/2021. The details regarding entrance test will be communicated to the candidates in due course of time.

12. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- i) **The candidates shall read the admission process carefully as stated in the prospectus.**
- ii) The candidate shall apply online, pay the fees, fill up the application form upload the desired documents and submit the same on or before last date of submission of application form.
- iii) Application primarily scrutinized for eligibility, validity of certificates and reservations applicable.
- iv) **Resubmission of deficient documents** – A list of candidates who failed to upload or have wrongly uploaded the desired documents will be displayed on website. These candidates will be required to upload only the indicated documents within the due date specified by the University for resubmission **(Annexure-XV)**.
- v) Additional documents will not be accepted after due date specified for the purpose of resubmission of deficient documents.
- vi) After final scrutiny, Provisional list of eligible candidates for Entrance Test will be displayed on university website.
- vii) Candidates aggrieved by the contents of the provisional list of candidates eligible for entrance examination may prefer an online appeal addressed to **The Registrar, MAFSU, Nagpur**, in the prescribed form of Grievance application available on university website. For the purpose of grievance the candidate have to pay the grievance application fees **Rs. 200/-** (Rupees Two Hundred) in any form as mentioned in the steps earlier and shall mention the specific reason of grievance before the last date for submission of grievance as mentioned in admission programme **(Annexure-XV)**.



- viii) In case the documents for constitutional reservation uploaded by the candidates are invalid or rejected by the authority as evident in provisional list of candidates eligible for entrance examination, then such candidates if eligible under Unreserved category will have to apply for grievance and pay the remaining application fees (i.e. Rs. 300/-) at the time of submission of grievance for consideration of candidature under Unreserved category in the final merit list.
- ix) *No additional documents will be accepted along with the grievance application form.*
- x) The Grievance sorting committee will examine the Grievances of the candidates on the basis of the documents enclosed along with his/her original application form only.
- xi) If the applicant fails to appeal on or before last date for submission of grievance, his/her grievance shall not be considered and no further correspondence in this regard shall be entertained.
- xii) The final list of eligible candidates for Entrance Test shall be prepared and notified on the university website by the Competent Authority.
- xiii) The marks obtained in the Entrance Test (Written examination & interview together) shall be considered to prepare the merit list for admission. In case of equal marks in the Entrance Test, the following procedure **(Tie – Breaker)** shall be adopted for deciding the merit of the candidate.
- First Level** : A candidate with higher corrected marks/points of M.V.Sc. degree or a degree equivalent thereto shall be considered, if the tie still persists then,
- Second Level** : A candidate with higher uncorrected CGPA / OGPA at M.V.Sc. or degree equivalent thereto shall be considered, if the tie still persists then,
- Third Level** : A candidate with higher CGPA / OGPA at B.V.Sc. & A.H. or degree equivalent thereto shall be considered, if the tie still persists then,
- Fourth Level** : A candidate with higher aggregate percentage of marks at XII examination shall be considered, if the tie still persists then,
- Fifth Level** : A candidate with higher aggregate percentage of marks at X examination shall be considered.
- xiv) After publication of final merit list, the admissions shall be given after taking into consideration merit, the option/preference(s) exercised by the candidates, applicable reservations and availability of seats.
- xv) The candidates should fully understand that the provisional admission to Ph.D. would be made on the basis of merit of “MAFSU Ph.D. Entrance Test-2020” and availability of the seats.



- xvi) **Candidate should note that it is essential for him/her to log in for submission of the option form/preference form for every round of admission. Otherwise he/she shall not be considered for admission during that round.**
- xvii) **First Round of Admission** - After receiving the option/preference form, the admission allocation list will be displayed on website (i.e.www.mafsu.ac.in) and the intimation regarding the same shall be sent to the candidates on their mobile phone & email address.
- The allotment letter shall be generated for those candidates who have been allotted the seats. The candidate shall personally visit the allotted college along with the printout of allotment letter, all original documents and admission fees to confirm his/her admission within stipulated period of time.
- xviii) **Once the seat is allotted as per candidate's first preference and the candidate does not report to college within the stipulated period of time mentioned in allotment letter, his candidature will be cancelled for next rounds. Whereas, if the seat is allotted as per candidate's second preference onwards and the candidate does not report to college, his/her candidature will be considered for next rounds of admission based on vacancies.**
- xix) Candidate shall be admitted provisionally till he /she registers him/herself in the concerned college where the seat is allotted.
- xx) At the time of admission, during the course of physical verification of the original certificates and documents, if it is noticed that the candidate is not entitled for the weightage(s) which has already been given to him and/or the category to which he / she belongs was incorrect, while preparing the final merit list, then he / she shall not be entitled for the admission during that round. In such case the University will amend the final merit list accordingly and the said applicant shall be considered eligible for admission as per his revised status in next round of admission.
- xxi) Candidate, who is admitted but fails to register / join the college within the period given by the Competent Authority or cancels the admission after joining, will not be eligible for admission during subsequent rounds.
- xxii) Once the admission is confirmed by the candidate the college will not be changed in any case.
- xxiii) Candidate shall pay the college fee at the time of confirmation of admission.



xxiv) **Second round of Admission** - The second round for allocation of seats, remaining vacant after first round of admission will be filled in during the second round as per the following stepwise procedure –

- Step I** - Filling of vacant seats separately in reserve and unreserved category as per vacancy position.
- Step II** - Conversion of female seats to male seats separately (if the female candidate of particular category are not available) in Reserve / Unreserved category.
- Step III** - Conversion of horizontal reservations into respective reserve & unreserved categories.
- Step IV** - Filling of vacant seats in reserve categories (if any) by SBC candidates (Max.2%).
- Step V** - Filling of remaining vacant seats by inter-se within reserve categories.
- Step VI** - After filling the vacant seats by Step I to Step V if there are any vacancies those will be filled in as per merit.

Note : After completion of every step the next step will start immediately.

- xxv) **Third round of Admission** - The seats remaining vacant after second round of admission will be allotted during the third round as per procedure mentioned for second round.
- xxvi) **Special admission round** - The seats remaining vacant after third round of admission will be filled in during the special round of admission. In case if any resultant vacancy, the seats will be filled by candidate as per merit from that respective category.
- xxvii) **Annexure IX, X, XI, XII and XIII** shall have to be submitted by candidate to the Associate Dean of concerned college where he/she has been admitted.
- xxviii) The admissions to various seats shall be final and once the candidate is admitted he/she will not be eligible for change of College or Quota.
- xxix) The candidate admitted under this University shall abide by rules and regulation of this University and changes made therein from time to time.
- xxx) If at any time after admission, it is found that the candidate has submitted false information / documents, the Competent Authority of the University shall cancel his / her admission without prior intimation.
- xxxi) Any candidate if found obstructing the admission process, trying to influence in unlawful manner and / or creating nuisance shall be liable for disqualification from the selection process. The decision taken by the Competent Authority in this respect shall be final and binding.



xxxii) All the admissions shall be deemed as provisional and subject to further scrutiny. It shall be liable for cancellation at any stage during the study of the students, if it is found that the admission was contrary to the rules or invalid by reason of incorrect or false information furnished by the applicant or parents/guardians at the time of admission. Any such cancellation of admission may lead to penal action.

xxxiii) Any issue not mentioned in prospectus shall be decided by the Competent Authority of the admission, which shall be final and binding.

13. ADDITIONAL WEIGHTAGE MARKS / POINTS

The CGPA / OGPA obtained by the candidate in 10 point scale in the qualifying examination i.e. M.V.Sc. or equivalent degree shall be taken as points. The CGPA/OGPA in 4 point scale will be converted to 10 point scale and then weightages will be added to calculate corrected points.

Conversion Formula of CGPA for 4.00 points Scale to 10.00 points Scale :

$$Y = 1.5 + 2X \text{ for } X = 2 \text{ to } 3.49 \text{ and}$$

$$Y = 8.5 + 3 (X - 3.5) \text{ for } X = 3.5 \text{ to } 4.00$$

where Y = CGPA in 10.00 point scale

and X = CGPA in 4.00 point scale

Additional weightage marks :

1. For Service experience for the first 10 years : 0.01 point for each completed year.
For subsequent completed years : additional 0.005 point per year.

*** Maximum points for service experience shall be 0.20 points**

2. For Research publications : 0.01 point for each Research Paper in NAAS rated National / International scientific journal.

*** Maximum points for Research Publications shall be 0.20 points**

Note :-

1. The self attested photocopies of the certificates/documents required for every additional weightage must be enclosed along with the application form, failing which the claim for additional weightage will be rejected.
2. The weightages will be added to CGPA / OGPA secured by the candidate in 10 point scale at M.V.Sc. or equivalent degree to calculate the corrected points.
3. The benefit of additional weightage shall be restricted to 0.40.



14. CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION

- i. If a student desires to cancel his / her admission for a bonafide reason, he /she will have to apply to the concerned Associate Dean of the College.
- ii. After receiving duly signed admission cancellation request letter from the candidate, the Associate Dean of the college shall cancel the admission immediately and inform the university regarding vacancy generated due to cancellation.
- iii. If a student cancels his / her admission and applies to the Associate Dean of the College is eligible to get refund of fees as per given below-

Sr. No.	Percentage if Refund of Aggregate fees	Remarks
1	100%	15 days or more before the formally-notified last date of admission
2	90%	Less than 15 days before the formally-notified last date of admission
3	80%	15 days or less after the formally-notified last date of admission
4	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days, after formally-notified last date of admission
5	00%	More than 30 days after formally-notified last date of admission

Note- a) In case of (1) mentioned in above table, the concern college shall deduct an amount not more than 5% of the fees paid by the student subject to a maximum of Rs.5000/- as processing charges from the refundable amount.

b) In case of (5) mentioned in above table, only the caution money shall be refunded to the student.

However, no refund except caution money will be admissible after cancellation of admission any time during the degree course or completion of degree course.

- iv) If candidate is admitted under NRI/FN/PIO quota, special fees deposited by such candidate shall not be refunded in any case.



PART - II
VETERINARY EDUCATION

1. **SYSTEM OF EDUCATION**

Course duration - The total course duration of Ph.D. is of 3 academic years i.e. six consecutive semesters for regular candidates as well as for those availing study leave.

English shall be the Medium of instructions & examination.

2. **REGISTRATION**

- i) After getting allotment letter from the University website, the candidate approaches to the Academic cell where he / she submit the allotment letter and makes the payment for Ph.D. degree course.
- ii) He/She submit the duly filled reporting slip in duplicate (one for Academic Cell and other for the candidate).
- iii) The Academic cell In-charge issues the blank Roster form in quadruplet (two for Academic cell, one for department and one for candidate).
- iv) He/She submit the duly filled reporting slip to the Professor / Sectional head of the respective discipline.
- v) He/She should fill the Major / Minor / Supporting / Non-credit compulsory courses in consultation of Professor / Sectional Head / Research Guide.
- vi) He/She should submit the duly filled Roster forms and signed by the student / course teachers, Chairman of the Advisory Committee, Professor or Sectional Head and Associate Dean to the Academic cell.
- vii) Fees be deposited in the office of the Associate Dean of the college from second semester onwards.

3. **ATTENDANCE**

It is mandatory for the students to attend minimum 75% of total number of theory and practical classes during the semester, failing which he / she will not be eligible to appear for the semester end examination & shall be declared failed in that semester.

4. **HOSTEL ACCOMODATION**

Hostel accommodation for a limited number of students is available at the constituent colleges of the University. Every student admitted to constituent colleges may not be necessarily provided hostel accommodation. Hostel facility is not available for boys at PGIVAS, Akola.

5. **DISCIPLINE**

1. The cases of unfair means and the cases of misbehavior will be dealt with as per the rules and regulations of the University in vogue and as amended from time to time.



2. Students while studying in the college, if allegedly found involving in activities like ragging, bullying or kidnapping and any other act of indiscipline shall immediately be suspended from the college as well as the hostel without any notice by the Associate Dean of the College and are liable to be expelled from the college by the Vice-Chancellor on the detailed report of the Registrar of the University.
3. As per the provision of Maharashtra Act XXXIII known as “**Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act of 1999**”, students indulging in ragging can be punished under the Act resulting in suspension, expulsion from the college and imprisonment. If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student will be given liberty to explain and if his / her explanation is not satisfactory, the authority would expel him from the institution.
4. The candidates admitted to Ph.D. degree course should have full understanding that the Authorities of the University have a right to expel the student from the college for any violation of the rules of conduct and discipline prescribed by the University.

6. **IMPORTANT ACADEMIC REGULATIONS**

(1) **Transfer of student within University**

Transfer of student within the University will not be permitted in any case.

(2) **Time limit for completion of degree**

Minimum Requirement: The minimum residential requirement for completion of Doctorate degree shall be six consecutive semesters from the date of admission. The Candidate admitted for the Doctorate degree may be declared qualified for the degree provided the candidate completes all the prescribed requirements maximum within 12 consecutive semesters from the date of admission to the Doctorate Degree programme, provided he/she registers for each semester regularly. If he/she fails to register for any of the semester, his/her admission shall be cancelled.

(3) **Break in Study**

Student shall be permitted to break his/her studies subject to following conditions –

- Candidate shall be allowed to take break in studies only after successful completion of courses of first two semesters registered by him/her. This condition shall not be applicable to female candidate availing maternity leave.
- The candidate shall have to apply for break in studies on valid reasons to the Registrar through concerned college along with the recommendation of the Associate Dean.



- Candidate shall be allowed a maximum break of two years once only during his/her Ph.D. Degree Course. However, female candidate shall be allowed a break for one semester on recommendation of registered medical practitioner during advanced pregnancy at any time of study. This special concession shall be given once during her course curriculum subject to having less than two children. Moreover, the student has to complete the degree programme in maximum period as prescribed in the regulation for completion of Ph.D. Degree and if the course curriculum is in vogue at that time.
- Candidate has to pay gap fees (equivalent to Registration Fees) of all the semesters at the time of registration after the break for which he/she could not register in order to continue his/her registration.
- Candidate shall have to complete all the prescribed requirements of Doctorate Degree course within 12 consecutive semesters from the date of admission.
- For re-admission, candidate shall have to apply to the Registrar through Associate Dean of the college.
- The absence other than mentioned above will be dealt as per academic regulation No. AC-04/2010.

(4) **Removal of name from roll**

The name of the student may be removed by the Registrar from the roll of the University duly recommended by the Dean/Associate Dean for any one or more of the following reasons in addition to Maintenance and Discipline regulation and Good Conduct Rules - 2001 for the students passed by the Executive Council vide Resolution No. 32/2001 of dated 17.08.2001.

- a) Non-payment of penalties/dues on or within the dates fixed for the purpose.
- b) Continuous absence for a period of fifteen days or more in classes without permission.
- c) Misbehavior of any kind including disrespectful conduct and acts of violence causing willful damage to the University property, participation in strikes, demonstrations or disturbances of any kind, behaving in such a manner as to bring the University or his/her teacher into disrepute.
- d) Violation of any of the University/College/Hostel Rules.
- e) Negligence in studies.

The discipline amongst students shall be maintained as per the provisions under section 56 of the MAFSU Act XVII of 1998.

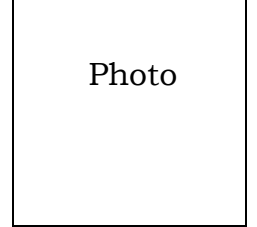
