REVISED GUIDELINES FOR MAFSU RESEARCH GRANT FOR PROMOTION OF RESEARCH ACTIVITIES AT CONSTITUENT COLLEGES

The University has decided to extend financial support to the faculty members working on regular establishment of the University for undertaking research on their original concepts/research projects/ R & D proposals. The details **of** the research grant proposed to be provided and guidelines for designing the project proposals thereof are as follows.

- 1. This special grant provided by the University from its own resources for promotion of research and shall be called as "MAFSU RESEARCH GRANT".
- 2. A total of 12 research grants will be awarded every year and their distribution will be as follows

- 3. Faculty member working on the regular establishment of the University in the capacity of Assistant Professor or equivalent and above shall be eligible to apply for the grant.
- 4. The proposal should be strictly as per the research mandate of college/ university encompassing the local issues.
- 5. Age limit of the applicant should be not more than 45 years to encourage the young faculty staff to fetch extramural research projects.
- 6. The duration of project to be undertaken under this scheme shall be one year (starting from April of present year to the March of next year).
- 7. The total value of the grant shall be Rs. 2.0 Lakh for the year 2024-25 and Rs. 2.5 lakh from the year 2025-26.
- 8. No financial support will be provided for civil works or purchase of major equipments under this scheme. However, minor equipments costing about Rs. 10,000 that are essential to meet the objectives of the work can be considered.
- 9. No financial support will be provided for hiring the technical manpower in the scheme however, the grant provided under contingency may be utilized by PI in meeting their of requirement of unskilled manpower.

- 10. The proposals received from the constituent colleges will be screened by the university level committee consisting of following.
 - i. Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Chairman
 - ii. Director of Research, MAFSU Member
 - iii. Two experts from the relevant field nominated by Vice Chancellor Members
 - iv. Deputy Director of Research Secretary
- 11. The committee may if it so desires invite the applicants for presentation of their projects.
- 12. Ideally the project should be led by a single investigator i.e. the PI. In exceptional cases where multidisciplinary projects are involved additional investigator (s) may be considered.
- 13. The maintenance of records of accounts, procedures to be followed for purchases will be as per the existing University rules.
- 14. The investigator of the project will have powers similar to those prescribed for the projects funded by externally funded agencies (Compendium, 2007)
- 15. Monitoring of the project will be done by the PME cells of respective constituent college and quarterly progress report will be submitted to the Directorate of Research.
- 16. The submission of utilization certificate/ audit utilization certificate has to be done similarly to that of other externally funded projects
- 17. The University level committee shall periodically review the progress of the project.

In case the progress of the project is not satisfactory the University shall have right to terminate the project and recover the grant from Principal Investigator.
